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1. Appropriate League Rules must be considered and KSTC's policy must not breach them.
 2. Captains meeting to take place before the start of each league season - summer & winter
 - Attendees - Match Secretary and all team captains (to allow for impartiality in squad selection).
 - Outcome - enable Captains to establish squads at the beginning of each new season, with guaranteed minimum player numbers for A team squads. Summer A team squad – at least 5 players of each gender, Winter Floodlit A & Winter Weekend League A team squads at least 4 players of each gender
 3. There will be separate squads for the A & B teams (and any other teams in the future) – ie not a single pool of match players.
 4. Captains to ONLY contact their own, agreed squad players when selecting teams for their matches
 5. Captains to liaise directly with other captains if they are short of a team player(s) to discuss a possible selection. Captains should NOT make direct contact with players from other team squads.
 6. After the start of a season A team players should not play for the B team, unless all B team squad members have been contacted (to give fair opportunity to all B team players) and there are insufficient numbers available to fulfil a specific fixture.

NB: Consideration needed if an A team player plays down & needs to declare their position as points may be conceded, (in line with League Rules). For example, in line with current Floodlit League rules long-established A team players are only available to the B team as a very last resort. If they are needed this must be declared to the opposition with the possible consequence of forfeiting points in the sets that they play in.

7. Captains need to plan ahead when selecting teams to minimise last minute player shortages. They should send out fixtures early to all squad players, and plan half the season's games in advance, advising players as soon as possible which matches they are in to avoid less dropouts. If squad players have not responded to emails about upcoming fixtures captains should follow up with phone calls.

NB: It is recommended that each captain sets up a WhatsApp group for their squad to provide an extra, speedy communication channel before and during a season.

8. When new playing members join the club AFTER the start of a league season they will be initially placed in a B team squad. If it is clear that they are A team player standard they will move up to the A team squad in the following season. They can be asked to step up for an A team match in the season in which they join if the A team have not enough squad players available for a particular match. In this instance their 'playing up' must not breach League Rules and they should not be used to the point that they are tied to the A team within that season without prior agreement of the other captain.
